Andrew Newman, MD, graduated from the College of William and Mary with his Bachelor of Science degree in 2000. In 2004, he graduated from the University of Virginia with his Doctor of Medicine degree. He completed residencies in Categorical General Surgery in 2009 and Independent Plastic Surgery in 2012, both from the University of

Pennsylvania. Most recently, Dr. Newman was an Assistant Professor of Surgery at Cooper Medical School at Rowan University and served as Chief of the Section of Microsurgery in the Division of Plastic Surgery.

Dr. Newman is board certified by the American Board of Plastic Surgery. He has clinical expertise in all forms of breast reconstruction, including perforator free flap reconstruction (DIEP flap, TUG flap), direct-to-implant reconstruction and pre-pectoral implant reconstruction. In addition to breast reconstruction, Dr. Newman performs microsurgical reconstruction of orthopedic trauma and orthopedic oncology.

He has peer reviewed publications on disparities in immediate breast reconstruction after mastectomy, reconstruction of hemipelvectomy defects with lower extremity free flaps and osteofasciocutaneous fibular free flap and radial head arthroplasty in trauma for limb salvage.

Dr. Newman has presented at several national meetings, and most recently delivered a Plastic Surgery Grand Rounds on pre-pectoral implant breast reconstruction.

He has earned several awards including 'Top Physicians' by *South Jersey Magazine*, the Leonard J. Perloff Chief Resident Award by the University of Pennsylvania and the Penn Pearl Annual Teaching Award by the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine.

Dr. Newman passionately develops individualized plans of care for his patients and emphasizes the patient's role in a multi-specialty, team-oriented approach to treatment.
