- Transition Age Youth
  - This is for individuals with autism between the ages of 15-18 to help develop their strengths for the transition into young adulthood. This program discusses topics including pre-vocational skills, dating, relationships, bullying, safe use of social media, wellness and more. Participants will participate in community enrichment activities such as volunteerism, socialization with a network of peers, exercise, cooking and more.
