Dr. Gupta joined the practice in 1999 and is board certified in neurology with added board certification in Electrodiagnostic Medicine (EMG). He also has additional training in EMG guided chemodenervation (with Botox/Phenol) for torticollis, focal dystonias, spasticity and other movement disorders.
