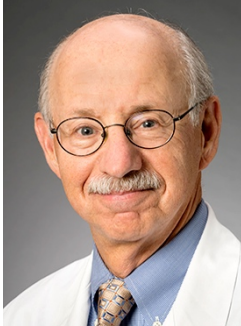


**BRUCE C. BERGER, MD**
