minimally invasive surgical techniques. Dr. Zebley has been on staff at Abington Memorial Hospital since 1997 and has been the Surgical Director of the GI Procedures Unit at AMH since 2002.

Dr. Zebley has both undergraduate (BA, Biological Sciences) and graduate (MS, Biomechanics) degrees from the University of Delaware, and he earned his MD from Temple University School of Medicine. He completed his internship and residency training in General Surgery at Abington Memorial Hospital, followed by a fellowship in Colon and Rectal Surgery at Washington University in St. Louis.

Dr. Zebley won the Peter White Research Award at the University of Delaware, and while a general surgery resident at AMH, he won 1st Place in the Eleanor Widener Dixon Resident Research Competition, and was named the Rosenfeld Surgical Scholar. His current research interests include surgical education and laparoscopic colectomy, and have produced presentations at many surgical meetings, including the Annual Clinical Congress of the American College of Surgeons, Annual Scientific Session of the American Geriatric Society, Conjoint Meeting of the Philadelphia Academy of Surgery and the New York Surgical Society, and the Frederick A. Coller (University of Michigan) Surgical Society, Pennsylvania Society of Colon and Rectal Surgeons, Philadelphia Academy of Surgery, Endo Expo of the Society of Laparoendoscopic Surgeons, and the San Antonio Breast Cancer Symposium.

Studies resulting from this research have appeared in the following peer-reviewed journals: *the American Journal of Surgery, the American Surgeon, Annals of Surgical Oncology, Diseases of the Colon and Rectum, Journal of Surgical Education, Journal of the Society of Laparoendoscopic Surgeons, and Surgical Endoscopy.*

Dr. Zebley is one of the primary instructors of laparoscopic colon surgery for the general surgery residents at AMH and he has taught other surgeons in practice minimally invasive laparoscopic techniques at workshops, sponsored by the American Society of Colon and Rectal Surgeons and by the University of Pennsylvania. His areas of special clinical interest include colonoscopy, laparoscopic colon surgery, and surgery for cancer. He was selected as a "Top Doc" in Colon and Rectal Surgery by Philadelphia Magazine in 2002. He first received a teaching appointment at Temple University School of Medicine in 1999.

Dr. Zebley is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons, the American Society of Colon and Rectal Surgeons, the Pennsylvania Society of Colon and Rectal Surgery, and the Philadelphia Academy of Surgery. He is a Member of the Society of American Gastrointestinal Endoscopic Surgeons, the Society of Laparoendoscopic Surgeons, and the Crohn's and Colitis Foundation of American.
