Dr. Ringold completed his extensive training with an additional fellowship in Interventional Endoscopy at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Campus, where he was also an Instructor of Medicine. For the past 5 years, he was the Director of Therapeutic Endoscopy at Drexel University College of Medicine and Hahnemann University Hospital. Dr. Ringold is board certified in Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology.

Dr. Ringold strongly believes in a multi-disciplinary approach to patient care in which he works closely with a team of physicians (internists, radiologists, surgeons) to develop a treatment and evaluation plan that is best-suited to the individual patient. He treats his patients like they are his family members. He takes the time to talk to them before and after the procedure to make sure all of their questions are answered and they are comfortable with the planned procedures.

In addition to performing routine endoscopy and colonoscopy, Dr. Ringold specializes in:

- All advanced endoscopic procedures, including endoscopic ultrasound
- Advanced endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatography (ERCP)
- Endoscopic treatment of malignant obstructions
- Endoscopic treatment of Barrett's esophagus
- Endoscopic mucosal resection of large polyps.

He also has interests in pancreatic cysts, gastrointestinal oncology for the staging and diagnosis of gastrointestinal cancers, complex polypectomy, complex pancreatic disease, and Barrett's esophagus.
