Anthony R. Rodriguez, MD earned his Bachelor of Science in Biology with a minor in Classics at Loyola Marymount University in 1984. In 1989, he earned his medical degree at Charles R. Drew University of Medicine & Sciences/UCLA School of Medicine. He completed his residency at Abington-Jefferson Health Hospital as the Co-Chief of Family Medicine.

Dr. Rodriguez has researched and presented work on various topics related to family medicine, such as: transgender health, gender neutral training, diabetes care, viral hepatitis in primary care, domestic violence in family practice, and LGBT healthcare. In addition to presentations, he assisted the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) Advisory Panel to develop the Hepatitis C recommendations Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report in 1994. From 2006 to 2015, Dr. Rodriguez was the Associate Dean of Student Affairs and Diversity at Drexel University College of Medicine where he led the Holistic Review Admissions project nationally to numerous medical schools and institutions. He worked with the Association of American Medical Colleges Group on Diversity and Inclusion as his medical school's representative and as the Northeast Regional representative.

Dr. Rodriguez has served his community in many capacities. From 1995-2012, he functioned as Preceptor at Drexel University. He trained over 50 individuals for their entire six week family medicine clerkship, which resulted in a number of students choosing family medicine as their specialty. From 2004-2013, he lead an annual STD Screening and Treatment course at Arcadia University. He has also served on several non-profit community boards and advisory panels.

- Disease management
- Coordination of care with specialists
- HIV medicine
- Adolescent care
- Substance abuse
- Medical resource utilization (specific to complex medical conditions, and multiple medical conditions)
