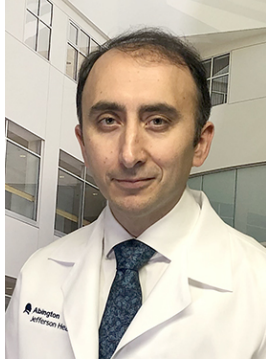


OSMAN S. KOZAK, MD

awarded for his Outstanding Performance in the National University Entrance Exam. Dr. Kozak is the associate director of Neurointerventional Care at the Neurosciences Institute.

- Mechanical removal of the intravascular clot
- Carotid artery stent placement
- Intracranial stent placement
- Particle or glue embolization
- Diagnostic cerebral angiography
- Balloon test occlusion

Dr. Kozak has written numerous medical research papers, including Posterior Reversible Encephalopathy Syndrome: Associated Clinical and Radiologic Findings, Super-Selective Intra-Arterial Magnesium Sulfate in Combination with Nicardapine for the Treatment of Arterial Vasospasm in Patients with Subarachnoid Hemorrhage, and Aspect Scoring of CT Perfusion in Acute Stroke Assessment.
