Mauricio J. Garrido, MD applies his background in engineering and cardiac medicine to cardiothoracic surgery at Abington Jefferson Health. Board certified by the American Board of Cardiothoracic Surgery, Dr. Garrido serves as Clinical Director of Cardiac Surgery at Abington Jefferson Health.

Dr. Garrido's extensive expertise includes treatment of ascending and descending thoracic aortic aneurysms, aortic dissection and coronary artery bypass in addition to aortic root surgery and mitral valve repair within the hospital's Porter Institute for Valvular Surgery. He has a specific focus on developing leading edge techniques in bloodless surgery to provide safe and effective heart surgery without the need for blood or blood component transfusion.

Dr. Garrido's surgical specialties include:

- Repair of complex acute and chronic aortic dissection
- Valve-sparring aortic root replacement
- Transcatheter aortic valve repair (TAVR/TAVI), transfemoral and alternate access approaches
- Heart valve reconstruction and replacement, including:
- Mechanical and bioprosthetic tissues (bovine, porcine, human)
- Adult congenital cardiac surgery
- Endovascular, surgical and hybrid treatment of thoracic aortic aneurysms
- Minimally invasive mitral valve repair
- Coronary artery bypass grafting
- Engineering principles applied to cardiac surgical management
- Bloodless surgery techniques in cardiac surgery
- Management of cardiac surgical disease in the elderly

Dr. Garrido has published numerous articles in cardiothoracic surgery journals and has presented at national cardiovascular conferences. While at Yale University School of Medicine, he was the recipient of the Wilbur Downs International Fellowship Award, a Distinction in Leadership honor, and was named National Hispanic Scholar. Dr. Garrido has traveled to India, Tokyo and Germany as the winner of academic or research scholarships to those countries.
