Abington Hospital's outpatient retail pharmacy, Alliance Pharmacy, is now registered as a Drug Take-Back location with the Pennsylvania Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs.

Employees and members of the community can now safely dispose of unwanted medications at a registered and convenient location, which will help reduce the number of unwanted prescriptions in our community.

Please note that the program does not accept the following products:

- Intravenous solutions
- Injectables, syringes and needles (e.g. EpiPens)
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Compressed cylinders or aerosols (e.g. asthma inhalers)
- Iodine-containing medications
- Alcohol and illicit drugs (i.e. marijuana, heroin, LSD)



Alliance Pharmacy is located on the first floor of the Buerger Building at Abington Hospital and is open Monday to Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
