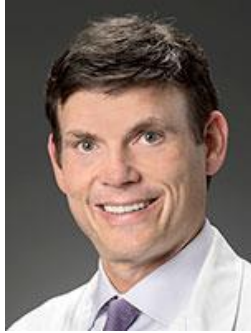

Mitchell I. Edelson, MD, graduated magna cum laude from Amherst College and received the John Simpson Medical Fellowship, the Obed Finch Slingerland Memorial Citizenship Prize and the Eugene S. Wilson Sportsmanship Award. After earning his medical degree at Sidney Kimmel Medical College, he completed his residency in Obstetrics & Gynecology at The Mount Sinai Medical Center in New York, NY. During his residency he received the Sidney Druce Chief Resident Award and the Mount Sinai Best Discussant of Research Award. He completed his fellowship in gynecologic oncology at Brigham and Women's Hospital, Harvard Medical School in Boston, Massachusetts. During his fellowship he was awarded the New England Association of Gynecologic Oncologists Dianon Award for his research about the molecular characteristics of ovarian cancer.

Dr. Edelson is board certified in Obstetrics & Gynecology and Gynecologic Oncology.

He has held multiple leadership positions at The American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, including the Chair of the Committee on Patient Education and the Chair of the Gynecologic Practice Subcommittee on Gynecologic Oncology. He served on the Editorial Committee for *Guidelines for Women's Health Care*. Additionally, Dr. Edelson served on the Board of Governors for the American College of Surgeons and is presently the American College of Surgeon's Chair of the Advisory Council for Gynecology and Obstetrics. He previously was the Chair of the Clinical Practice Committee for the Society of Gynecologic Oncology.

Dr. Edelson has published research articles in numerous peer reviewed journals. He was the senior author of recently published, "Neoadjuvant Chemotherapy for Newly Diagnosed, Advanced Ovarian Cancer: Society for Gynecologic Oncology and American Society of Clinical Oncology Clinical Practice Guideline".

He enjoys interacting with medical students and residents and has received teaching awards from multiple institutions.
